- **St. Tammany Fire District 2 Millage Election is June 27, 2026**
- The fire millage currently paid is 20.62 mills and the district is asking our citizens to consider a 10-year renewal at the same millage for another 10 years.
- Simply put this is a renewal of an existing tax and will not raise or lower your taxes.
- The Fire District has only one millage for fire protection. Without your support, fire protection will cease to exist once the current millage runs out.

The renewal of 20.62 mills will cost the following for the listed home values.

Residential Property Fair Market Value	Taxable After Homestead Exemption	Annual Cost	Monthly Cost
\$250,000	\$17,500	360.85	30.10
\$350,000	\$27,500	567.05	47.25
\$450,000	\$37,500	773.25	64.44
\$550,000	\$47,500	979.45	81.62

**Homeowners are already currently paying 20.62 mills so there will be no increase or decrease in taxes.**

# What will the Funding be Used For?

- A **YES** vote for the millage renewal ensures that the members of St. Tammany Fire District 2 will be able to continue to provide the great services currently being provided.
- This funding is used to support our employees for the jobs they perform, pay for the daily operations of the department and allows for capital improvements to apparatus, equipment, and facilities.

# St. Tammany Fire District 2 PIAL rating (Property Insurance Association of Louisiana)

- From 2017 to 2024 the fire district has lowered its PIAL rating from a Class 5 to Class 1. Class 1 is the highest possible rating. Achieving this rating clearly shows we are maximizing your tax dollars and progressively moving forward.
- Lowering of the fire district's property insurance rating has a direct impact on lowering the public's insurance rates for all residential and commercial properties in the district. Without this renewal insurance rates will be affected in a negative way.
- This could not be accomplished without our taxpayers continued support, the input from our Board members and the continuous work of our employees always putting the community first.

St. Tammany Fire District 2 operates out of 4 stations protecting 37 square miles serving a population of approximately 24,000 people .

St Tammany Fire District 2 is a fully paid fire department employing 51 people who are all trained and certified as fire fighters. Personnel are also trained and certified to deal with medical emergencies, vehicle extrication, hazardous materials incidents, and various other types of specialized rescue.
